Overview

- Since 01.01.2010 the submission of annual reports in XBRL is mandatory
- Estonian GAAP taxonomy (forms for profit-oriented entities, non-profit associations and foundations)
- Exeptions
- Web solution
 - Annual accounts to be submitted either by filling in the set forms or by uploading an XBRL instance file
 - Formula like custom solution for validation
 - Generation of PDF reports, that can be signed digitally!
 - Auditor participation in process



XBRL taxonomy development

- Cooperation with various institutions
 - Ministry of Justice
 - Ministry of Finance
 - Statistics Office
 - Tax Authorities
 - Estonian Accounting Standards Board
 - Estonian Board of Auditors
 - Bank of Estonia
 - Estonian Chamber of Commerce and Industry
- Don't forget about end-users!




Changes in submission process

BEFORE 3 months



NOW 20 minutes





Some technical aspects

- User extensions to taxonomy are not allowed (alternative know-how for reporting data extension is available!)
- Submission either by filling in the set forms or by uploading an XBRL instance
- Support of formula like value assertions
- Digital signature (Belgium, Portugal, Lithuania, Finland)



Pros and Cons

Pros

 Processing of business data at the time of submission; less errors; no need for paper; cost and time saving; multy-language and etc.

Cons

- Accountants doesn't know XBRL
- XBRL tagging in accounting software



Results

- E-reporting environment makes the submission of data significantly more convenient for companies, as there is one specific place, form and way for submitting all required data
- The same (reported) data may not be asked by different authorities multiple times
- Estonian entrepreneurs claim that it has reduced their time consumption in the matter of submission of annual reports
- Users prefer usage of web forms
